#### Overview

Dementia is a common presentation in general practice. It is the leading cause of death in women in Australia and second leading cause of death overall.

This webinar has been designed to assist GPs and nurses in their interactions with people with dementia and their family/carers. The webinar will include an interactive discussion with panelists outlining frameworks for making it easier to assess people presenting with dementia.
